GENERAL INFORMATION/INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., North San Diego County Alumnae Chapter invites graduating seniors of North San Diego County area high schools and matriculating college students of North County to apply for the North San Diego County Alumnae Chapter (NSDCAC) Scholarship Awards. This year four \$1,000 scholarship awards will be awarded to qualifying HS seniors, and four \$1,000 scholarships awarded to matriculating community college and University students of North San Diego County.
- Eligibility for this scholarship is intended for African American students defined above and enrolled at primary and secondary schools within North San Diego County that exemplify community service and academic achievement.
- If not completed online, a printed copy of the completed application packet must be postmarked or date-stamped no later than **March 31, 2023**, and mailed to the chapter P.O Box address. P.O. Box 462121, Escondido, CA 92046-2121.

The completed application packet must contain the following:

- An official high school transcript to verify a minimum 3.0 GPA on an overall 4.0 GPA scale.
- Demonstrated record of extracurricular activities in leadership and community service.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation, i.e. school administrators, counselors, teachers, community leader, employer, etc. All letters of recommendation must be typed and uploaded (preferably on letterhead).
- The acknowledged need for financial assistance based on current family income.
- One (1) page, essay addressing the application writing prompt found below.

All sections of the NSDCAC Scholarship Application must be completed with accompanying documents and be time-stamped or postmarked by March 31, 2023. Completed application packets will be screened and evaluated by the scholarship committee. Note: Late scholarship application submissions will only be considered under extenuating circumstances for which we have been notified in advance.

Essay Prompt 3: “What are your skillsets or interests that are unique and set you apart from others?”
